**New Business**

**1 E. Dakota**

The City received three bids for the demolition of 1 E. Dakota from DWD Construction for \$74,000, Harvey Brothers Trucking & Wrecking Co INC. for \$60,200 and Green Deconstruction for \$25,500. Koehn made a recommendation to council to go with Green Deconstruction for the project. Koehn explained the bid came back much lower from Green Deconstruction because they will salvage most of the material from the building. Motion by Phillips to accept the bid from Green Deconstruction and move forward with a contract, seconded by Jett.
